

ARTICLE 5: SPECIFICATIONS

The Clermont County Commissioners are soliciting bids to establish a contract for fuel to be used in County Vehicles. The desired term for the contract will be for a period of one-year, with an optional second year.

Fuel: Gasoline provided shall be 87 Octane. Diesel fuel provided shall be supreme or super grade. There is the possibility that Clermont County will change to Biodiesel instead of supreme or super grade diesel, so alternate bids for Biodiesel will be accepted.

Emergency Delivery: Emergency delivery may be required. In most cases, this will happen in the event of a weather system requiring the treatment of the County roads. Please detail availability of deliveries during this type of event, including contact names and numbers for Saturday ordering and possible Saturday or Sunday delivery.

Quantities: The following quantities were used during 2005, from January to December.

- 87 Octane Unleaded Gasoline - 265,284
- Supreme or Super Grade Diesel - 128,719

The above quantities should be used as estimates for bidding purposes.

Safety Data Sheets: Upon award of this bid, it will be required that the successful bidder provide the Clermont County Fleet Maintenance Center with the proper material safety data sheets for all fuels.

Diesel Fuel Treatment: Anti-gel diesel fuel conditioner will be required to be added by the vendor to each diesel fuel delivery.

Pricing: Prices for any bid shall not include any taxes. Prices for "Base Bid (A)" shall be a fixed price contract for the period of the contract.

Prices for "Base Bid (B)" shall be a cost differential over the "Oil Price Information Service" AVERAGE under the heading 'PAD 2 Gasoline and Distillate Reseller's Prices' and sub-heading 'Cincinnati, OH'. The cost differential shall remain constant for the

length of the contract. The "Oil Price Information Service" is published by the United Communications Group, 11300 Rockville Pike, Suite 1100, Rockville, MD 20852-3030 and is published weekly, every Monday. The successful bidder's selling prices are to be established each Monday that the "Oil Price Information Service" is published and said prices must remain firm for the ensuing week. Selling price must be rounded to the nearest hundredth cent.

In the event that the "Oil Price Information Service" ceases publication and/or a viable listing of reference prices relating to Cincinnati, Ohio is no longer available through the "Oil Price Information Service", the parties to this contract must mutually establish a replacement price index.
