**RESOLUTION FINDING THAT JTD REALTY INVESTMENTS, LLC FAILED TO COMPLETE THE TERMS OF THE PERFORMANCE AND MAINTENANCE BOND DATED THE 24<sup>TH</sup> DAY OF SEPTEMBER, 2008 SECURED BY OFFICIAL CHECK NUMBER 004385 FROM FORCHT BANK IN THE AMOUNT OF \$22,000.00 AND AUTHORIZING THAT THIS AMOUNT BE DRAWN FROM THE CONTRACT TRUST FUND AND PLACED INTO THE MOTOR VEHICLE AND GAS FUND FOR COMPLETION OF THE PERFORMANCE BOND...**

WHEREAS, JTD Realty Investments, LLC submitted a Performance and Maintenance Bond for the construction of streets covering the subdivision known as Locust Lake Estates, Pierce Township, Clermont County, Ohio, which Bond was dated the 24th day of September 2008 and secured by Official Check Number 004385 in the amount of \$22,000.00 issued by Forcht Bank,, which was deposited into the Contract Trust Fund; and

WHEREAS, upon recommendation of the Office of the County Engineer, the Board finds that the performance and maintenance to be undertaken has not been completed in a timely manner in accordance with the terms and conditions of the Bond.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Clermont County, Ohio with at least two-thirds of its members thereto concurring as follows:

### **SECTION I**

That the Board of County Commissioners hereby certifies that JTD Realty Investments, LLC has defaulted on its contract obligations to the County pursuant to the Performance Bond for sidewalks from JTD Realty Investments, LLC executed the 24th day of September, 2008 by failing to perform the completion, construction, repair and maintenance of sidewalks, and the Board of County Commissioners therefore certifies that JTD Realty Investments, LLC has not fulfilled its contract obligations as called for in the subdividers contract for Locust Lakes Estates Subdivision, and therefore the Board of County Commissioners is obligated to complete said performance in the amount of \$6,400.00.

### **SECTION II**

That the Board hereby determines that the amount necessary to complete and perform such construction activities to cure the default of JTD Realty Investments, LLC is in the amount of \$6,400.00 and that the County Engineer is hereby authorized and directed to present the Clermont County Auditor a certified copy of this Resolution, authorizing the draw of \$6,400.00 from the Contract Trust Fund to be placed into the Motor Vehicle and Gas Fund for completion of said improvements.

### **SECTION III**

That the County Engineer, upon review and approval by the Office of the Prosecuting Attorney of Clermont County is hereby authorized to execute all necessary documents and/or bank drafts on behalf of Clermont County and/or the Clermont County Board of Commissioners.

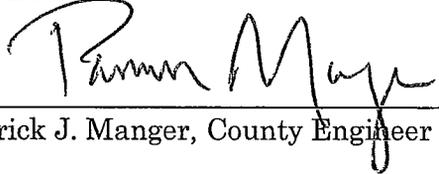

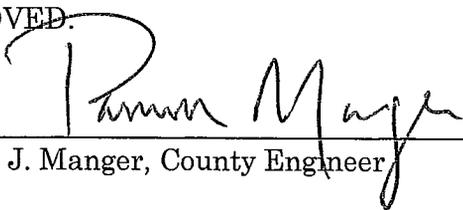

**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR  
TO EXECUTE CONTRACTS FOR PUBLIC IMPROVEMENT MINOR  
PROJECTS, PROFESSIONAL SERVICES CONTRACTS, AND SERVICES  
CONTRACTS**

**WHEREAS**, the County undertakes maintenance, improvements and repairs of various county facilities and property on a regular basis; and

**WHEREAS**, the County requires the assistance of outside contractors from time to time to perform minor public improvements and under the supervision of the responsible County offices to perform certain services in accordance with the work specifications developed by said office; and

**WHEREAS**, in order to facilitate hiring contractors for work to be performed within relatively short periods, the Commissioners desire to allow the County Administrator to execute contractual documents for minor public improvement work; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of County Commissioners of Clermont County, Ohio with at least two-thirds of its members thereto concurring as follows:

**SECTION I**

That the County Administrator is hereby authorized to execute on behalf of the Board of County Commissioners contracts for public improvement minor projects, professional services contracts, and services contracts with qualified contractors as selected and recommended by the responsible County office to perform limited work services for costs less than \$50,000 under the

supervision of said office. Such Contractor shall be independent contractors and not considered employees of the County and other than supervision by the appropriate County office as acting as General Contractor, shall undertake all work without control by the County of their means and methods of completing the services in accordance with the Scope of Services to be incorporated into the contract.

## SECTION II

That the County Administrator shall cause all such contracts in excess of \$15,000.00 to be brought before the Board of Commissioners in a timely manner for ratification after execution by the County Administrator in order to allow the services to be performed quickly and without the necessary delay of being brought formally before the Board of Commissioners for execution.

The County Administrator is directed to supervise the selection of contractors by the appropriate County office and to insure that all contractual documents are complete and the Scope of Services outlined is consistent with the appropriations for the project and the plans and specifications developed with regard to the project.

## SECTION III

That the Board of County Commissioners hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the passage of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Board, and that all deliberations of this Board and its Committees, if any, which resulted in formal action, were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with all applicable legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
