RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING APPROVAL OF THE CLERMONT COUNTY STORM WATER MANAGEMENT PLAN AND AUTHORIZING FILING WITH THE OHIO ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY

WHEREAS, the Clermont County Storm Water Task Force, comprised of municipalities and townships within Clermont County, with the involvement of personnel from several county level offices and departments, has revised the Clermont County Storm Water Management Plan, first adopted by the Clermont County Board of Commissioners on March 6, 2003 and revised on August 18, 2010, in compliance with the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) storm water permitting program that addresses six minimum control measures, including: Public Education, Public Notification/Involvement, Illicit Discharge Detection and Elimination, Construction Site Stormwater Runoff Control, Post-Construction Stormwater Management, and Pollution Prevention/Good Housekeeping for Municipal Operations. The plan is intended to reduce pollutant loadings from stormwater runoff to the maximum extent practical under current state law, to protect water quality, and;

WHEREAS, the local governments within "urbanized areas" as defined by the U.S. Bureau of the Census require a storm water permit from the Ohio EPA. Within Clermont County, these governmental entities include: Clermont County Board of Commissioners, Clermont County Engineer's Office, Clermont County Park District, City of Milford, Village of Amelia, Village of Batavia, Village of Owensville, Village of Williamsburg, Batavia Township, Goshen Township, Miami Township, Monroe Township, Ohio Township, Pierce Township, Stonelick Township, Union Township, and Williamsburg Township, and;

WHEREAS, the most cost effective and efficient approach for addressing the Phase II stormwater rule is to implement a regional approach that utilizes and expands on existing programs and references the Clermont County Water Management and Sediment Control regulations and complies with the requirements of Ohio EPA's Phase II Stormwater Program, and all jurisdictions have participated in the development of the plans and desire to participate in the implementation of the plan, and;

WHEREAS, the current Storm Water General Permit for "Small Municipal Separate Storm Sewer Systems," issued by the Ohio EPA on September 11, 2014, contains requirements that necessitate a revision to the Clermont County Storm Water Management Plan.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Clermont County, Ohio:

- SECTION 1. That the Board hereby adopts the Clermont County Storm Water Management Plan upon the recommendation of the County Administrator and the Administrator for the Clermont Soil and Water Conservation District upon the review and approval of the Office of the Prosecuting Attorney, and further authorizes and instructs the Administrator of the Clermont Soil and Water Conservation District to insure the timely filing of the Storm Water Management Plan to the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency.
- SECTION 2. That the Board hereby repeals the Storm Water Management Plan, dated August 18, 2010, in its entirety.
- SECTION 3. That the Board of County Commissioners hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the passage of this resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Board, and that all deliberations of this Board and its Committees, if any, which resulted in formal action, were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with all applicable legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
