RESOLUTION TO SETTLE ADVERSARY CLAIMS IN BANKRUPTCY COURT AND TO RELEASE RETAINAGE ON O'BANNON AND BRAMBLEWOOD PROJECTS

WHEREAS, Clermont County Board of County Commissioners ("BCC") contracted with Atlas Excavating, Inc. to install sewer lines as part of the O'Bannon Unsewered SR28 Sewer Assessment Project #6402-60062 [hereinafter "O'Bannon"] and contracted with Atlas Excavating, Inc. to install sewer lift stations as part of the Bramblewood Trunk Line Project #6402-60068 [hereinafter "Bramblewood"];

WHEREAS, Atlas Excavating, Inc., in turn, subcontracted with Walker & Sons

Construction, Inc. on both aforementioned projects in addition to other projects not involving the

Clermont County BCC;

WHEREAS, Walker & Sons Construction, Inc. filed bankruptcy in the federal district court in the Southern District of Indiana, Indianapolis Division, Case No. 11-00020-FJO-11;

WHEREAS, Walker & Sons Construction, Inc. commenced an adversary action in said bankruptcy case against Atlas Excavating, Inc. which involved several projects, two of which were the Bramblewood and the O'Bannon projects;

WHEREAS, Clermont County BCC was included as a nominal party in the bankruptcy litigation as it holds the retainage accounts on both projects;

WHEREAS, Atlas Excavating, Inc. and Walker & Sons Construction, Inc. entered into the attached settlement agreement in order to resolve the differences between them that were the subject of the adversary claim;

WHEREAS, the various vendor claims, including any claims by the subcontractors and suppliers, will be discharged when the bankruptcy is concluded and the statute of limitations for a claimant to assert a lien on either project has passed;

WHEREAS, as part of the settlement agreement, Atlas Excavating Inc. agrees to indemnify the Clermont County BCC against any claims made against it with regard to both the Bramblewood and O'Bannon projects;

WHEREAS, the BCC closed the O'Bannon project on June 1, 2011 though the retainage of \$25,987.04 was left in the account due to the bankruptcy filing;

WHEREAS, the BCC overpaid Atlas Excavating Inc. \$36,364.02 on the Bramblewood project but the retainage in the account is \$29,638.94 which leaves Atlas Excavating Inc. owing the BCC \$6,725.08;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners of Clermont County, Ohio:

1. The Clermont County Board of County Commissioners agrees to the Settlement Agreement and Release of Claims in *Walker & Sons Construction, Inc. v. Atlas Excavating, Inc. et al.*, Case No. 11-00020-FJO-11, United States Bankruptcy Court, Southern District of Indiana, Indianapolis Division.

- 2. The retainage on the Bramblewood project will be released to the Board of County Commissioners.
- 3. Atlas Excavating, Inc. will receive \$19,261.96 plus any accrued interest from the retainage of the O'Bannon project. This amount represents the difference between the retainage on O'Bannon project (\$25,987.04) and the overpayment by the BCC on the Bramblewood project (\$6,725.08).

Local Time, at which hearing all evidence pertaining to the proper amount of the assessments and the question of benefits was considered along with evidence offered for and against the assessments; and

WHEREAS, proof of publication of the hearing notice has been filed with the Clerk of the Board of County Commissioners and the Clerk has filed her certificate showing service of the notices by certified mail upon the owners.
