RESOLUTION OF NECESSITY FOR PURCHASE OF AUTOMOBILES FOR THE USE OF THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS; ANY COUNTY DEPARTMENT, BOARD, COMMISSION, OFFICE OR AGENCY; OR ANY ELECTED COUNTY OFFICIAL OR HIS OR HER EMPLOYEES

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Clermont County, Ohio are required by Ohio Revised Code §307.41, to find, by resolution of necessity, that it is necessary to expend county monies for the purchase or lease of automobiles to be used by the County Commissioners, by any county department, board, commission, office or agency, or by any elected county official or his or her employees, and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Clermont, County, Ohio has previously adopted Resolution 25-12 on February 22, 2012 authorizing the purchase of 38 new vehicles during the 2012 calendar year, and Resolution 71-12 on May 9, 2012 to add the purchase of 4 used buses, and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Clermont, County, Ohio has before it a recommendation to expend county monies for the purchase of one additional motor vehicle in 2012 for use of the Veterans Service Commission, and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners by this resolution have legally appropriated monies from the proper fund for the acquisition of vehicles,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,** by the Board of County Commissioners of Clermont County, Ohio with at least two-thirds of its members thereto concurring as follows:

#### **SECTION I**

That the Board of County Commissioners of Clermont County, Ohio, does hereby declare that a necessity exists to purchase one (1) replacement vehicle.

### **SECTION II**

#### RESOLUTION NO. 194 -12

The Board of County Commissioners, Clermont County, Ohio, met in regular session on the 12thday of December, 2012, with the following members present:

Mr. Uible moved for the adoption of the following resolution:

RESOLUTION APPROPRIATING AND TRANSFERRING THE REMAINING UNENCUMBERED CASH BALANCES FROM SIX (6) SPECIFIC PERMANENT IMPROVEMENT FUNDS TO A SPECIAL FUND FOR THE ACQUISITION OF PERMANENT IMPROVEMENTS PURSUANT TO SECTION 5705.14(B) OF THE OHIO REVISED CODE AND RESCINDING THOSE SPECIFIC PERMANENT IMPROVEMENT FUNDS AND RE-ESTABLISHING THE COUNTY CAPITAL FUND UNDER SECTION 5705.13(C) OF THE OHIO REVISED CODE

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has established six (6) specific permanent improvement funds for the purpose of accumulating resources for the acquisition, construction, or improvement of fixed assets of the County, which funds are entitled Detention Fund, Medical Social Services Building Fund, Emergency Communications Capital Fund, Courthouse Construction Fund, Sheriff Office Construction Fund and Municipal Court Capital Fund; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has contributed to these capital project funds from the county General Fund, bond proceeds, grants, property tax, note proceeds, investment earnings and from other county capital funds; and

WHEREAS, the balances from the bond, note and grant proceeds in these funds were entirely expended and all remaining balances from General Fund contributions; and

WHEREAS, there currently remains no outstanding debt service from the funds, and no money is required in the funds to meet any obligations payable from such funds; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code section 5705.14(B) the Board may transfer the unexpended balance in any specific permanent improvement fund to a special fund for the acquisition of permanent improvements, provided that such money is not required to meet the obligations payable from such funds; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners desires to continue the acquisition of permanent improvements of the County under one fund namely, County Capital Fund (4007), and no longer utilize the separate specific permanent improvement funds; and

**WHEREAS,** Ohio Revised Code section 5705.13(C) permits the Board of County Commissioners to establish a capital projects fund for the purpose of accumulating resources for the acquisition, construction, or improvement of fixed assets of the subdivision.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of County Commissioners of Clermont County, Ohio with at least two-thirds of its members thereto concurring as follows:

# **SECTION I**

That the Board of County Commissioners of Clermont County, Ohio hereby transfers the following unexpended balances in the Detention Fund, Medical Social Services Building Fund, Emergency Communications Capital Fund, Courthouse Construction Fund, Sheriff Office Construction Fund and Municipal Court Capital Fund and authorizes the following appropriations and transfers of the specified fund balances to the County Capital Fund (4007) and authorizes Linda Fraley, County Auditor, to properly record same pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 5705.14(B). and to rescind and cancel the Detention Fund(4001), Medical Social

Services Building Fund(4002), Emergency Communications Capital Fund(4003), Courthouse Construction Fund(4004), Sheriff Office Construction Fund(4006) and Municipal Court Capital Fund(4014):

## **SECTION II**

That the Board of County Commissioners hereby re-establishes the County Capital Fund (4007) which was originally established in 1991, before the enactment of Ohio Revised Code 5705.13(C), as a capital projects fund under the authority provided by Ohio Revised Code 5705.13(C), for the purpose of accumulating resources for the acquisition, construction, or improvement of fixed assets of the county, with the source of funds being the General Fund monies residing in the six building-specific capital funds described above, the Board-determined allocation of the County's property tax inside millage receipts, grants, bonds, property tax related state revenues, and any reimbursements due to the capital fund to be utilized during the ten year period 2012-2021 in compliance with the county capital plan as attached or as updated from time to time.

## **SECTION III**

That the Board of County Commissioners hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the passage of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Board, and that all deliberations of this Board and its Committees, if any, which resulted in formal action, were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with all applicable legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
