WHEREAS, the County of Clermont, Ohio (the “County”) is a party to a Development Agreement dated as of December 28, 2005 (“Development Agreement 1”), by and between the County and M/I Homes of Cincinnati, LLC, an Ohio limited liability company, and its successors and assigns (“Developer 1”), including the Drees Company, a Kentucky corporation (“Drees”), pertaining to the proposed development of approximately 43.4 acres of real property within Goshen Township (“Property 1”) and related public infrastructure, as further described in Development Agreement 1; and

WHEREAS, the County is a party to a Development Agreement dated as of December 28, 2005 (“Development Agreement 2” and together with Development Agreement 2, the “Development Agreements”), by and between the County and Trenton Properties, LLC, an Ohio limited liability company, and its successors and assigns (“Developer 2” and together with Developer 1, the “Developers”), including Vancouver Homes Inc., an Ohio corporation (“Vancouver”), pertaining to the proposed development of approximately 72.9 acres of real property within Goshen Township (“Property 2”) and related public infrastructure, as further described in the Development Agreement 2; and

WHEREAS, a portion of Property 1 remains undeveloped, and Property 2 remains undeveloped; and

WHEREAS, the obligations of the County under the Development Agreements are binding against the County and enforceable by the Developers, but only with respect to the undeveloped portions of Property 1 and Property 2; and

WHEREAS, the County, Drees as current owner of the undeveloped portion of Property 1, and Vancouver as current owner of Property 2, desire to terminate the Development Agreements for the purpose of facilitating future development of Property 1 and Property 2; and

WHEREAS, this Board of County Commissioners has determined that it is necessary and proper and in the best interests of the County to execute a Termination of Development Agreement with respect to each of Development Agreement 1 and Development Agreement 2 to effect the termination of such Development Agreements;
