RESOLUTION TO INITIATE VACATION OF PORTION OF BIG INDIAN ROAD

WHEREAS the Board of Trustees of Washington Township has submitted a resolution seeking the vacation of a portion of Big Indian Road; and

WHEREAS the portion of Big Indian Road to be vacated terminates in the middle of Big Indian Creek; and

WHEREAS the parcel north of the portion to be vacated has access for ingress and egress via an easement over adjacent properties; and

WHEREAS the Board of County Commissioners finds that it would be for the public convenience or welfare to vacate a portion of Big Indian Road; and

WHEREAS, the portion of Big Indian Road to be vacated begins at the last township culvert on Big Indian Road, located approximately 3,322 feet from the intersection of the centerline of Big Indian Road (T-33) and State Route 743, and terminates approximately 163 feet west/northwest to a point in the middle of Big Indian Creek.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of Clermont County, Ohio with at least two-thirds of its members thereto concurring as follows:

SECTION I

That the Board of Commissioners of Clermont County Ohio, pursuant to R.C. 5553.04, does hereby resolve to view the proposed vacation on 8/18/2026 at 9:00 a.m./p.m. and to hold the final hearing on the proposed vacation on 8/19/2026 at 11:00 a.m./p.m. at the office of the Clermont County Board of County Commissioners, 101 E. Main Street, Batavia, Ohio 45103.

SECTION II

That the Clerk is directed to cause notice of the viewing and hearing to consider the vacation of a portion of Big Indian Road to be published in the Clermont County Sun once a week for two consecutive weeks beginning 7/30/2026, and to cause a copy of the same notice to be delivered by first class mail at least twenty days before the date of the public hearing to all owners of property abutting upon the portion of the road to be vacated, by mailing it to the addresses of such owners appearing on the county auditor's current tax list.

SECTION III

That the Board of County Commissioners of Clermont County, Ohio does hereby find and determine that all formal actions relative to the passage of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Board, and that all deliberations of this Board and its Committees, if any, which resulted in formal action, were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with all applicable legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
