RESOLUTION OF NECESSITY FOR PURCHASE OF MOTOR VEHICLES FOR THE USE OF THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS; ANY COUNTY DEPARTMENT, BOARD, COMMISSION, OFFICE OR AGENCY; OR ANY ELECTED COUNTY OFFICIAL OR HIS OR HER EMPLOYEES

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Clermont County, Ohio are required by Ohio Revised Code §307.41, to find, by resolution of necessity, that it is necessary to expend county monies for the purchase of motor vehicles to be used by the County Commissioners, by any county department, board, commission, office or agency, or by any elected county official or his or her employees, and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Clermont, County, Ohio has before it a recommendation to expend county monies for the purchase of replacement vehicles in 2013 for use of the Sheriff's Office, Facilities Management, Common Pleas Adult Probation, Building Inspection, Municipal Probation, Clermont Transportation Connection, Water Resources, Solid Waste District and the Department of Job & Family Services, and

WHEREAS, the acquisition of these vehicles will be made from monies legally appropriated to the proper fund(s) by the Board of County Commissioners,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners of Clermont County, Ohio with at least two-thirds of its members thereto concurring as follows:

SECTION I

That the Board of County Commissioners of Clermont County, Ohio, does hereby declare that a necessity exists to purchase vehicles as detailed in Section III as replacements for existing county vehicles.

SECTION II

That the Board of County Commissioners of Clermont County, Ohio, does hereby declare that the number of motor vehicles required to be purchased is thirty-two (32) for use as replacement vehicles.

RESOLUTION TO SUPPORT THE SELECTION OF THE OHIO VALLEY REGIONAL DEVELOPMENT COMMISSION (OVRDC) AS A REGIONAL TRANSPORTATION PLANNING ORGANIZATION (RTPO) THROUGH THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION'S REGIONAL TRANSPORTATION PLANNING ORGANIZATION PILOT PROGRAM AND AGREEMENT THAT CLERMONT COUNTY WILL ACTIVELY PARTICIPATE IF THE OHIO VALLEY REGIONAL DEVELOPMENT COMMISSION IS SELECTED.

WHEREAS, since the early 1990s, the Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT) has been informally consulting with elected officials in rural Ohio in the development of the Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP); and

WHEREAS, in order to formalize these communication streams and enhance the statewide planning process, ODOT is initiating a Regional Transportation Planning Organization (RTPO) Pilot Program which will evaluate the benefits of adding transportation planning processes to existing multi-county regional planning agencies' planning programs; and

WHEREAS, the Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT) is soliciting proposals from multi-county regional planning agencies which do not currently serve as Metropolitan Planning Organizations (MPOs) to participate in a two (2) year Regional Transportation Planning Organization (RTPO) Pilot Program, which will begin in July of 2013; and

WHEREAS, agencies which are selected to participate in the Pilot Program will work with ODOT to add transportation planning processes to their existing planning programs and participation in the Pilot Program is intended to assist in the development of transportation planning expertise through mentoring and transportation plan development, and will provide a forum for formalized consultation with ODOT regarding statewide and regional transportation issues; and

WHEREAS, Clermont County is a political subdivision located in and currently participating in economic and community development efforts of the Ohio Valley Regional Development Commission (OVRDC); and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners of Clermont County, Ohio with at least two-thirds of its members thereto concurring as follows:

SECTION I

That Clermont County supports the selection of the Ohio Valley Regional Development Commission (OVRDC) as a Regional Transportation Planning Organization (RTPO) through ODOT's RTPO Pilot Program and will actively participate in the RTPO program of OVRDC if selected.

SECTION II

That the Board of County Commissioners hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the passage of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Board, and that all deliberations of this Board and its Committees, if any, which resulted in formal action, were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with all applicable legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
