



# Additional Funding for All-Gravity Collection System

- May 4, 2018 meeting with USDA / RD
- Redesign will require revision to Preliminary Engineering Report
- \$5M loan limit in Ohio...if exceeded file must be sent to National Office for review
- Current Loan=\$4,052,164
- Additional cost for all-gravity collection system, plus WWTP upgrades can be funded using a combination grant and loan
- Will require a new loan agreement (just for additional funds)
- +/-2.75% interest rate, 40 years no prepayment penalty

# Schedule for Redesign

- USDA/RD Loan Agreement approved April 1, 2016
- Must close on loan within 5 years of agreement date (April 1, 2021)
- Start Construction by January 1, 2020 (15 month construction schedule)
- Start redesign ASAP...goal to be complete by mid-September, 2018
- Will require amended resolutions and new public hearing

# Revised Assessment Roll

- System Capacity Fees (current rates)
  - \$3,340 for Single Family Residential
  - \$1,400 per one bedroom multifamily unit
  - \$1,990 per two bedroom multifamily unit
  - \$2,670 per three bedroom multifamily unit
  - \$4,450 for ¾" non-residential
  - \$4,900 for ¾" non-residential with food service
- Proposed WWTP has 23,000 gpd available for future growth
  - 23,000 gpd = 105 EDU's
  - 105x\$3,340 = \$350,700
- Existing homes/businesses/apartments
  - Capacity fees estimated at \$539,110
- Total Capacity Fees (Est.) = \$889,810
