TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT (CCTID) BOARD OF TRUSTEES**

**WHEREAS**, the Board of County Commissioners of Clermont County, Ohio, adopted Resolution No. 124-06 on June 21, 2006 which created the Clermont County Transportation Improvement District (CCTID), pursuant to Chapter 5540 of the Ohio Revised Code, to empower the various political subdivisions and their respective residents within the County, to participate in a cooperative county-wide coalition to take advantage of the opportunities and benefits made available only through a TID to plan, construct and improve highways, roads, bridges, interchanges and accompanying capital improvements and development throughout Clermont County and its surrounding counties, such as Hamilton County and specifically regarding the Eastern Corridor Multi-Modal Project, and

**WHEREAS**, said Resolution approved the establishment of the Clermont County Transportation Improvement District (CCTID) Board of Trustees, pursuant to Section 5540.02(A) and (C) (2) of the Ohio Revised Code, and approved the appointment of the CCTID Board of Trustees by the Board of Clermont County Commissioners to serve as the five (5) voting members comprising the CCTID Board of Trustees, and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of County Commissioners of Clermont County, Ohio, wishes to designate the membership of the Clermont County Transportation Improvement District Board of Trustees.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of County Commissioners of Clermont County, Ohio with at least two-thirds of its members thereto concurring as follows:

**SECTION I**

That pursuant to Section 5540.02(A) and (C) (2) the Board of Trustees to serve as the five voting members comprising the Clermont County Transportation Improvement District Board of Trustees shall be appointed for a two year term effective June 21, 2018 through June 20, 2020 in their official capacity as follows:

1. The Assistant County Administrator of the Board of County Commissioners of Clermont County, Ohio
2. The Township Administrator of the Board of Miami Township Trustees, Clermont County, Ohio.
3. The Township Administrator of the Board of Union Township Trustees, Clermont County, Ohio
4. The Clermont County Engineer.
5. The President/CEO of Lykins Energy Solutions

**SECTION II**

Be it further resolved that two nonvoting members continue to be appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives and the President of the Senate of the Ohio General Assembly.

**SECTION III**
