<u>DISCUSSION:</u> Craig Stephenson, Chief Deputy County Engineer, Clermont County Engineer's Office, explained that the proposed Application for Financial Assistance is a means for the County to apply for Ohio Public Works Commission (OPWC) Funds for Phase I of the Old SR 74 Improvements Project located in Union Township and also identifies the Chief

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Executive Officer, the Chief Fiscal Officer, the Project Manager for the afore-stated Project. Upon approval of the Application, it is anticipated that the Project Agreement will be submitted to the Board of County Commissioners on or after 07/01/2019 for execution. Mr. Stephenson stated that the initial Application for Financial Assistance prepared in late 2018 included funding from the Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT)/Ohio-Kentucky-Indiana Regional Council of Governments (OKI) for the Project in the amount of \$5,650,000.00. Since that time, the County Engineer's Office worked with OKI and successfully increased the amount of their participation to \$7,650,000.00 (a \$2 million increase). These additional funds decrease the commitment of the Clermont County Transportation Improvement District (CCTID) for said Project (with the total Project amount of \$11,000,000.00 remaining the same as noted below).
