LET THE RECORD SHOW: The Board of County Commissioners, Clermont County, Ohio, issued a Proclamation designating the month of August 2019 to be "Child Support Awareness Month" in Clermont County".(19-0115-004)

LET THE RECORD SHOW: PAM HAVERKOS, DIRECTOR, CLERMONT COUNTY EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY, PRESENTED THE FINAL ALL-HAZARDS MITIGATION PLAN UPDATE. MS HAVERKOS HAS BEEN WORKING WITH ALL COUNTY AGENCIES OVER THE LAST EIGHT (8) MONTHS TO UPDATE THE PLAN. THE PLAN PROTECTS LIVES AND PROPERTY THROUGH THE IDENTIFICATION OF HAZARDS AND DEVELOPMENT MITIGATION STRATEGIES TO REDUCE OR ELIMINATE RISK.

MS. HAVERKOS STATED THE PLAN IS REQUIRED BY 44 CODE OF FEDERAL REGULATIONS PART 201.3 AND THE ROBERT T. STAFFORD DISASTER RELIEF AND EMERGENCY ASSISTANCE ACT. EVERY COUNTY, VILLAGE AND CITY MUST HAVE AN ALL-HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN. THIS IS THE COUNTY'S THIRD UPDATE OF THE PLAN WHICH IS REQUIRED TO BE UPDATED EVERY 5 YEARS. THE PLAN WILL BE REVIEWED BY OHIO EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY (OEMA) AND THE FEDERAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY (FEMA) IN SEPTEMBER 2019. THE PLAN ADOPTION TIMELINE IS DECEMBER 2019 FOR THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS AND DECEMBER 2020 FOR ALL CITIES, TOWNSHIPS AND VILLAGES TO ALSO ADOPT THE PLAN. THIS PLAN IS AN ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENT FOR PRE/POST-DISASTER MITIGATION GRANTS.

MR. PAINTER ASKED HOW THIS PLAN RELATED TO THE PROTECTION OF THE COUNTY'S WATER SUPPLY. LYLE BLOOM, WATER RESOURCES DEPARTMENT (WRD) DIRECTOR, EXPLAINED A SEPARATE WELL FIELD PROTECTION PLAN COVERED THIS. PAM HAVERKOS SAID A REFERENCE TO THE WRD PLAN COULD BE INCLUDED IN THE HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN.

LET THE RECORD SHOW: JEREMY P. EVANS, ACTING CLERMONT COUNTY ENGINEER, PRESENTED THE 2018 ANNUAL REPORT OF ROADS, BRIDGES AND CULVERTS FOR THE COUNTY OF CLERMONT, OHIO, PURSUANT TO SECTION 5543.02 OF THE OHIO REVISED CODE. THIS REPORT REFLECTS THE CONDITIONS OF 385 MILES OF ROADS, 416 BRIDGES AND 2,656 CULVERTS IN CLERMONT COUNTY. CLERMONT COUNTY IS CURRENTLY ON A 38-YEAR PAVING CYCLE. THE RECENTLY PASSED LICENSE PLATE FEE AND FUEL TAX WILL ASSIST IN THE REPAIR OF ROAD, BRIDGES AND CULVERTS WITH SOME OF THE FUNDS BECOMING AVAILABLE IN AUGUST 2019 WITH FULL FUNDING NOT REALIZED UNTIL 2020.

MR. EVANS SAID THE 2018 CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS CONSISTED OF \$760K FOR ROAD PROJECTS, \$1.16M FOR BRIDGE PROJECTS AND \$610K FOR NEW EQUIPMENT PURCHASES FOR A TOTAL INVESTMENT OF \$2.53M OF WHICH \$435K WERE GRANT FUNDED.

2019 CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS TOTAL 16 ROADS REPAIRED (36.13 MILES), 11 ROADS TO BE RESURFACED, 3 LANDSLIDE PROJECTS AND A MODIFIED PLAN OF 8 BRIDGES IN 4 TOWNSHIPS TO BE REPAIRED. (19-0220-003)
