WHEREAS, a developer of an alternative energy generation facility has expressed interest in constructing an energy project in Clermont County, provided that the appropriate incentives are in place to support the economic performance of the project; and

WHEREAS, the Board is willing to provide real and tangible personal property tax exemption to support the development of an alternative energy generation facility, conditioned upon the appropriate service payments made pursuant to O.R.C. 5727.75(G); and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Clermont County Board of Commissioners authorizes and approves this Qualified Energy Application from Nestlewood Solar I LLC and that this application for property tax exemption submitted by the Department of Community and Economic Development is approved expressly conditioned upon the receipt of an annual service payment in addition to the annual service payment required under O.R.C. 5727.75(G).

Section 1. The amount of each annual service payment shall be the difference between \$9,000.00 and the payment required and made under O.R.C. 5727.75(G) per megawatt

multiplied by the nameplate capacity in megawatts of the energy project in Clermont County, Ohio.

Section 2. The annual service payment required by Resolution 105-20 shall be paid on or before the final date for payment of taxes on public utility personal property, on the real and public utility personal property tax list for each tax years for which the property of the energy project is exempt from taxation pursuant to O.R.C. 5727.75.

Section 3. The annual service payment required shall be paid by Nestlewood Solar I LLC, 909 Lake Carolyn Parkway, Suite 260, Irving, TX 75039, the owner of the energy project located at Nestlewood Solar 80 MW Solar Electric Generating Facility located in Tate Township, Clermont County, Ohio and Clark Township, Brown County, Ohio as outlined in Exhibit "A" attached hereto. Upon receipt of the annual service payment, the Clermont County Treasurers Office is directed to deposit this into the general operating fund of the county. Both of the payments required pursuant to O.R.C. 5727.75(G) and authorized pursuant to O.R.C. 5727.755(E) (1)(b) shall be charged and collected at the same time and in the same manner as the taxes imposed on taxable property subject to assessment under O.R.C. 5727.

Section 4. The Department of Community and Economic Development is directed to send a copy of Resolution 105-20 by certified mail to the director or owner of each energy project that is the subject of a permit from the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC) and Ohio Power Siting Board (OSPB) and/or any other approved applications or permits from the State of Ohio submitted by the director or owner of each project to the Board of County Commissioners within 30 days after the request is received by the Board.

Section 5. The Clerk of the Board shall also provide a certified copy of this Resolution to the Clermont County Auditor and Treasurer within 30 days after passed; as well as copies of any

approved applications or permits received from the director or owner of potential developments once received by the Department of Community and Economic Development.

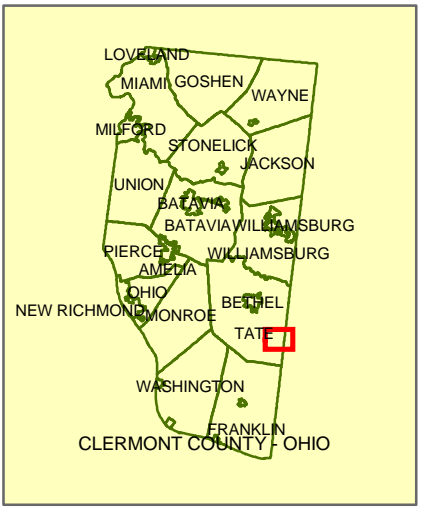
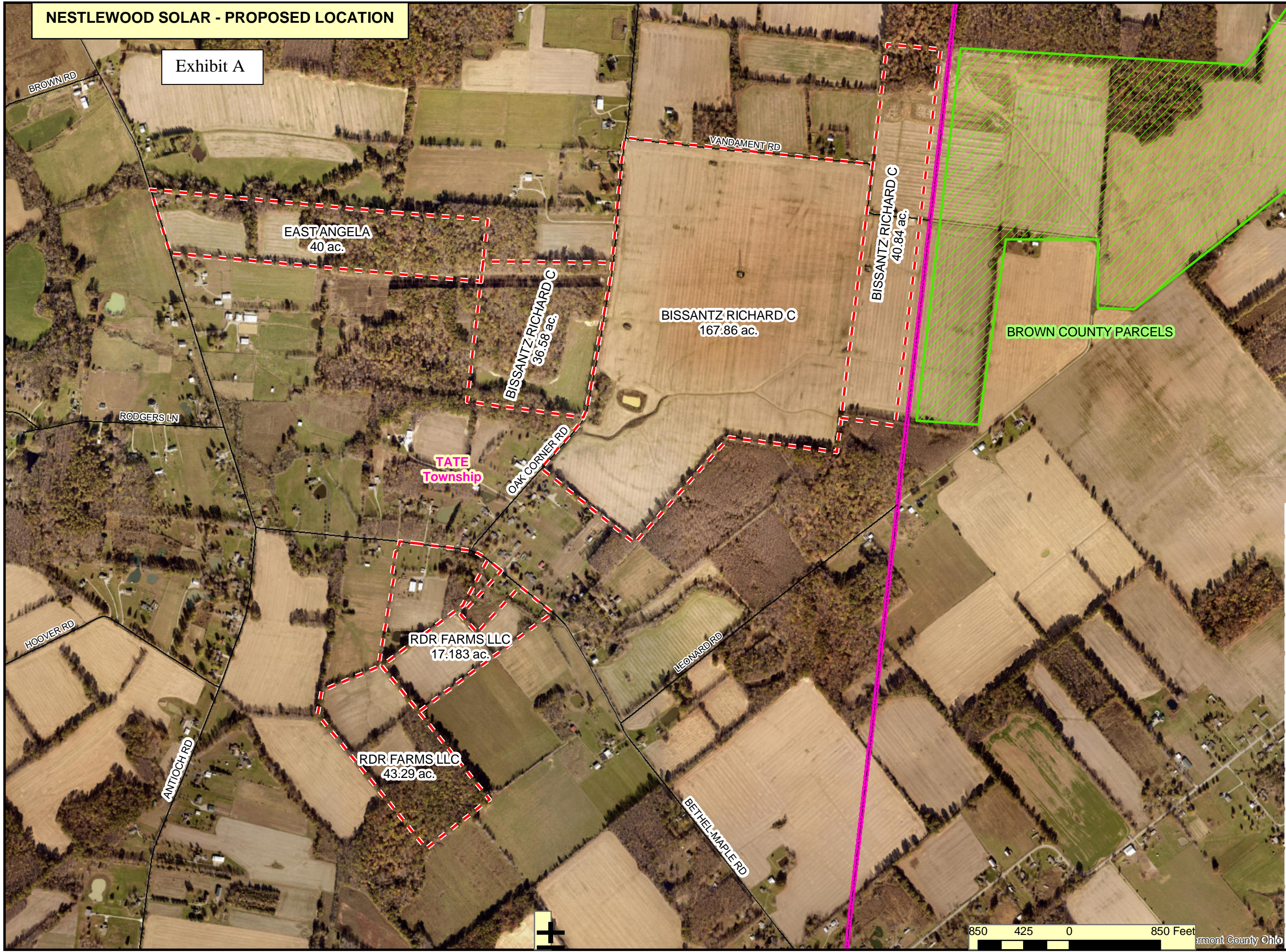
