A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE FILING OF AN APPLICATION WITH THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2024 OHIO TRANSIT PARTNERSHIP PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio through its Fiscal Year 2024 Programs has made Available funds to assist public transportation systems in Ohio; and

WHEREAS, the Clermont Transportation Connection is the transit operator for the Board of County Commissioners of Clermont County, Ohio; and

WHEREAS, the Clermont Transportation Connection is presently providing transit service and observing all federal and state rules regarding these programs; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Clermont County, Ohio, with at least two-thirds of its members thereto concurring as follows:

SECTION I

That Megan Dale, Program Manager of Clermont Transportation Connection is hereby authorized to file an Application with the Ohio Department of Transportation for the Fiscal Year 2024 Ohio Transit Partnership Program, on behalf of the Board of County Commissioners of Clermont County, Ohio for the sum of up to \$250,000 to be used for state match on federal allocation funds in order to fund capital facility projects, and to authorize Bonnie J. Batchler, President of the Board of County Commissioners, to execute the Standard State Assurances.

SECTION II

That Megan Dale, Program Manager, Clermont Transportation Connection, is authorized to furnish such additional information as the Ohio Department of Transportation may require in connection with this Application.

SECTION III

That the Board of County Commissioners hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the passage of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Board, and that all deliberations of this Board and its Committees, if any, which resulted in formal action, were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with all applicable legal



requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

WHEREAS, numerous residents and interested citizens have voiced their concern as to the posted 45 MPH speed limit on Branch Hill-Loveland Road (C-19) beginning at 0.45 miles north of Branch Hill-Guinea Pike and ending at the Loveland City limits in Miami Township, a total length of 1.53 miles or 8,078.4 feet.

AND WHEREAS, this Board feels that for the general public welfare and safety of the traveling public, the speed limit on the above mentioned road should be changed.

NOW THEREFORE IT BE RESOLVED: that the State of Ohio, Director of Transportation is hereby requested to change the speed limit on the above mentioned road and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Clermont County hereby agrees, in the event the speed limit is changed on the above mentioned road, to erect and maintain appropriate signs and markings,
